NATURE OF THE WORK

The Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board is inviting applications for teachers in Welding and Fitting in its Vocational Training sector.

THE PROGRAM AND TASKS

The Welding and Fitting Program is an 1800 hour program focusing on the acquisition of the qualifications needed to enter the labour market;

- to acquire the qualifications needed to interpret plans, specifications and procedures;
- to acquire the qualifications needed to prepare and weld steel, stainless steel and aluminum parts according to different processes: SMAW, CTAW, GMAW, FCAW;
- to acquire the qualifications needed to carry out, modify and repair assemblies;
- to apply occupational health and safety rules; to control the quality of products built.

Candidates should have working experience in the field of welding.
