As per the directives of the Minister of Education, Vocational Training classes are now being offered on-line, to our students. These sessions are organized by your teachers and are conducted on the Zoom platform, according to your assigned schedule.

Teachers will offer on-line learning for the theory competencies and, after May 19, it will be possible for students to be invited into the center, **by appointment only**, for the technical competencies and for evaluations.

Attendance will be taken in all Zoom sessions, and failure to attend these sessions will have serious consequences in terms of your projected program completion and certification dates.

In some programs, this could mean that modules not attended and completed would have to be taken at a later date, in the fall session, space permitting.
